Currently, Lionel Walden Primary School has eight classes which are organised as follows:-

Class 1 Reception Class 2 Year 1 \_ Class 3 Year 1/2 Class 4 Year 2/3 Class 5 Year 3/4 Class 6 Year 4 Class 7 Year 5 Class 8 Year 6

The school's published admission number (PAN), from September 2015, is 30. Children who have their fourth birthday by 31<sup>st</sup> August are able to start in the Foundation Stage (Reception) in September of that year. The application process opens in the October/November of the preceding year through Cambridgeshire County Council.

The following oversubscriptions criteria are adhered to:-

Children who have a statement of Special Educational Needs that names the school will be admitted. Those children with a statement of special educational needs that does not name the school will be referred to the Statutory Assessment and Resources Team to determine an appropriate place.

- 1. Children in Care, also known as Looked After Children (LAC), and children who were looked after but ceased to be so by reason of adoption, a resident order or special guardianship order.
- 2. Children living in the catchment area with a sibling at the school at the time of admission.
- 3. Children living in the catchment area.
- 4. Children living outside the catchment area who have a sibling at the school at the time of admission.
- 5. Children living outside the catchment area who have been unable to gain a place at their catchment area school because of oversubscription.
- 6. Children who live outside the catchment area, but closest to the school as measured by a straight line.

In cases of equal merit in each set of criteria, priority is given to children living closest to the school as measured by a straight line.
