Walk to School Week: 20th - 23rd May 2019

We are fast approaching 'Walk to School Week' - an event we have participated in, every May and November, for several years - to help cut down congestion outside the school gate as well as increasing levels of exercise and promoting a healthy lifestyle.

Walking to school also helps develop better road sense and greater independence. Accidents do happen, but this should not deter us from going out - it should make us realise the importance of keeping alert and thinking ahead. Walking to school provides an opportunity for children to think about ways to deal with difficulties and how to stay safe. It also helps to cut pollution. We want our children to be safe, confident and independent and walking to school is a healthy and environmentally friendly way to learn many invaluable life skills.
