Dear Parents,

We are pleased to inform you that we have organised an educational visit for our Year 4 class on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> June to the Museum of Zoology in Cambridge. The educational focus of our day is 'Skeletons', what they are, how they work and why they are important. The coach will leave school at 8.45 a.m. and return before the end of the school day.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch as well as a small snack for mid-morning. Children may wear non-uniform clothes, which are suitable for a school visit, and sensible footwear, e.g. trainers. If the weather is wet, a waterproof coat will be required. Sunhats and sun cream should be worn if hot weather is forecast. Please let us know if your child suffers from travel sickness, or any other medical condition, which may affect them on this visit.

In order for this trip to go ahead, a contribution of £16.75 per child is required. This covers the cost of coach travel and teaching resources at the museum. If insufficient contributions are received, unfortunately the trip will not take place.
