Measuring the impact of PPG spending

The school evaluated the impact on each pupil at the end of each term. Evaluation focused on progress in Reading, Writing and Mathematics and how pupils' self-confidence developed as a consequence of the intervention programmes.

End of Year Summary (July 2015)

Foundation Stage:

4 out of 7 (57%) of PPG pupils achieved a Good Level of Development

Year 1 Phonics Check:

2 out of 3 (66%) of PPG pupils achieved the required standard

End of Key Stage 1:

No pupils were eligible for PPG funding

End of Key Stage 2:

4 pupils were eligible for PPG funding

100% achieved a Combined Level 4 for Reading, Writing and Mathematics

25% (1 pupil) achieved a Combined Level 5 for Reading, Writing and Mathematics

25% (1 pupil) achieved Level 6 in Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling

100% made at least 2 levels (expected) progress in Reading, Writing and Mathematics

50% made 3 levels (exceeding the expected level) progress in Reading
