I am extremely pleased with how well you are all doing completing the Home Learning Packs and using the online resources to support you with your learning. It is wonderful to see so many emails with fantastic work attached to share with me. It is nearly half-term! You can keep using your time wisely but do not forget to have a rest too. In today's new Home Learning Pack, I have included some Maths, English and Science revision work. The Maths pack has a range of different mathematical strands and can be used along-side the following concepts:

- Multiplication and Division
- Counting up in different amounts
- Addition and Subtraction
- Fractions
- Telling the Time.

The English pack has a range of different areas including some comprehension, SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) and adjectives. In addition to this, since so many of you enjoyed the previous Science learning, I have included some work on grouping and researching different rocks, alongside some experiments for you to try! Please continue to read a range of other books/reading material from home and keep practising your spellings and handwriting.

Other writing opportunities can include:

- A summer poem using alliteration or rhyming words
- A bug/plant hunt fact-file
- A diary entry by someone from the past, e.g. a Viking, Tudor, Victorian, Ancient Egyptian, etc.



- A narrative story using adjectives and adverbs – try to include inverted commas
- Book reviews
- A chronological report on a documentary you have watched
- Writing instructions using imperative (bossy) verbs and time conjunctions.
