IMPORTANT INFORMATION IN RESPECT OF CHILDREN CURRENTLY ATTENDING SCHOOL

In order to assist us in keeping our school community safe, please can I remind you of the need to inform us immediately by email (office@lionelwalden.cambs.sch.uk), should anyone in your household develop Covid-19 symptoms or have a Covid-19 test. This also includes the period after school closes for the half-term break so that we can inform close contacts (those in affected bubbles) should there be any positive cases.
