KICKASH PROGRAMME FOR YEAR 6 PUPILS

As part of our planned work in PSHE and Science, we are pleased to be able to offer the children in Year 6 the exciting opportunity to work with students from Cromwell Community College as part of the Cambridgeshire Kick Ash Programme. This is a programme led by young people, encouraging their peers to be proud to be smoke free.

The students who will be working with us have been trained as mentors, as part of the Kick Ash programme. Their work with us will focus on the following areas:

- Recognising peer influence and its affect on decision making and behaviour;
- Developing understanding of healthy lifestyle choices;
- Developing attitudes towards the presentation of tobacco in the media;

The work will not directly review the children's understanding of the health affects of smoking, but will focus on peer influence, image and identity as reasons why a few young people choose to start smoking in their teenage years.
