

Questionnaire for Parents - July 2022

As a school, we are continually striving to provide the very best experiences for our pupils and families. We would appreciate you sharing with us what you consider we do well, in addition to what we could do even better. Your views are important to us and careful consideration will be given to them.

This year, school has been open to all pupils since September, however, during this time we have still had to follow Covid measures and limit activities. Having parents in school to join us for activities and events is what we greatly missed during the last couple of years but, thankfully, we have been able to welcome you back into school this term. Thank you very much for coming in to watch our children perform so well in their Class Assemblies - they were absolutely brilliant and it was the first performance in front of an audience for many of our children. Year 2 parents have attended Reading Café sessions. Sports Afternoon was enjoyed by many of you. The LWSA were able to reintroduce the Summer Fair, Cake Stalls and Book Stalls and are now operating a School Uniform Exchange.

Please consider the broad curriculum we offer such as themed weeks (Science Week, International Week, Healthy Week, Walk to School/Road Safety Weeks), Internet Safer Internet Day, World Book Day, music tuition with a Music specialist peripatetic teacher (Years 1 to 5), swimming lessons for pupils in Years 3 to 6, Bikeability sessions for Year 6 pupils, Rugbytots and PE lessons with sports coaches for cricket, tennis, tri-golf and rounders. The Year 4 worked collaboratively with the Museum of Zoology on the Butterfly Project. Year 6 were visited by 'STEM in the Fens' - a chance to find out about robotic arms and how they are used in keyhole surgery.
