Dear Parents,

To support our topic 'All About Me', the children are invited to bring in a favourite toy from home to show to their friends. The children will be encouraged to take turns within a group and talk about their toy. During these circle sessions, they will begin to develop the skills needed in order to listen to others, take turns within a group, develop a range of vocabulary, ask questions of others and respond to how and why questions.
