HOME LEARNING PACKS

Due to the current situation surrounding the coronavirus, staff have been very busy preparing Home Learning Packs in the event of us being directed to close the school. **Should** this occur, pupils will be provided with a named pack which may include reading books, handwriting and spelling practice, English tasks, Maths activities and project based work. Whilst these tasks will not match the level of learning pupils would have received through direct teaching in school, we hope you understand that staff have given careful consideration to what can be reasonably completed at home.

Teachers have produced guidance as to what could be completed each day - this is specific to your child's year group. Pupils should be encouraged to follow a timetable which includes breaks for physical activity. Log in details have been provided for those year groups which access online platforms such as Accelerated Reader, Rockstars Times Tables and PiXL Times Tables so that these can be continued.

Please encourage your child to follow the same standards of presentation as they would in school - joining their handwriting consistently (generally from Year 2 upwards), underlining with a ruler where required and correctly forming numerals in Maths. All packs should be returned on the first day of school reopening.

This letter is being circulated today as we have some families self-isolating who have requested work to be sent home as soon as possible - these parents/carers should contact the School Office to make arrangements for collection of work. Should the school close, Home Learning Packs will be sent home with pupils on the last working day.

We very much appreciate the support and understanding we have received from parents/carers so far during this difficult and unprecedented time.
