Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2015/16

Regardless of their ability, or prior attainment, those children eligible for Pupil Premium, receive additional support within their classroom.

Support for pupils includes the development of skills in Numeracy and Literacy including focused work on phonics/reading where appropriate.

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

The impact of Pupil Premium funding and the details of additional support provided by the school will be evaluated half-termly.

Evaluation will focus on individuals' progress in Reading, Writing and Mathematics.

The impact on pupils' confidence, self-esteem, well-being and attitude to learning will be reviewed.

The school's Governing Body will receive progress reports at each meeting.

End of Year Summary (July 2016)

Foundation Stage:

1 out of 3 (33%) of PPG pupils achieved a Good Level of Development

Year 1 Phonics Check:

5 out of 6 (83%) of PPG pupils achieved the Required Standard

End of Key Stage 1:

4 pupils were eligible for PPG funding (1 of these left prior to the end of the year)

2/3 (66%) achieved the Expected Level for Reading

2/3 (66%) achieved the Expected Level for Writing

3/3 (100%) achieved the Expected Level for Mathematics

1 pupil achieved *Greater Depth* within the Expected Standard in Reading, Writing and Mathematics

End of Key Stage 2:

5 pupils were eligible for PPG funding

4/5 (80%) achieved the Expected Level for Reading

4/5 (80%) achieved the Expected Level for Writing

2/5 (40%) achieved the Expected Level for Mathematics
